Study #2: Love & Obey

John 14:15-21

NOTE: If you have not viewed the video, do so first, then come back to these questions.

Questions to ask

1. John said on Sunday morning that he finds it easy to obey a person who has mastered something he wants to master. Is that true of you? Who do you find it easy to obey? If God easy to obey for you?
2. The kind of love that Jesus spoke of in John 14:15 and demonstrated for us on the cross (Ephesians 5:2) is a love that “seeks the best for another person at a cost to yourself”. How does this sit with you? Share a time when you have received that kind of love, or given that kind of love.
3. How do you feel about this correlation between love and obedience that Jesus describes? He speaks of this in different ways four times in 9 verse. Check out John 14: 15,21,23,24. Why do you feel that Jesus is so intent on us getting this “right.”
4. Share some stories around times that you have obeyed the gentle nudge of God to do something small for another person that may have cost you something. Share the feeling you had (if you can remember) that came with serving another for the glory of God.
5. Pray for each other this week to have ears to hear God speak into your hearts to connect with another person with the aim of blessing them.
